

Please Support Lane Walker Rudkin Workers

The receivers of textile and apparel maker Lane Walker Rudkin (LWR) announced on Friday 15 May 2009 that 186 clothing workers in Christchurch and the Wairarapa would be made redundant.

The workers have been thrown out with no notice, and no money: the workers may see their last wage payments, but there is no guarantee they will see their holiday or redundancy pay.

The workers want a better response from LWR's banker (Westpac) and the government: if LWR in receivership cannot guarantee their holiday and redundancy pay, then Westpac and the Government need to do something more concrete to help.
